What is a Twitter Conference?

Twitter conferences are becoming very popular among the research community.

Can I participate?

It is free.

You just need to have a Twitter account (https://www.twitter.com). You can be a part of the conference without leaving your office (low carbon and cost-free) wherever and whenever you want.

How can I join?

First step: If you do not have a twitter account, you will have to make one. It is very easy.

Second step: You need to search our hashtag #IHERP18 to see all the posts related to the conference.

Third step: Using services such as Tweetdeck, Hootsuite or Buffer can help you.

Guidelines for presenters:

1st step: **Register**. If you are interested in making a presentation register within the deadline (until 10th June) by email (aph.herpetos@gmail.com) with the correspondent abstract (see bellow the instructions).

- Your presentation can be a maximum of 6 tweets (each tweet is 280 characters)
- Every tweet needs to be numbered (1-6 and start with the hashtag #IHERP18). For example: 1 #IHERP18 -...
- Your tweets should follow the logic of a conference presentation (intro -1, methods2, results-3, summary-4)
- Pictures, graphs or GIFS are encouraged
- Presentations should be no more than 10 minutes.
- After the presentation, it will be given 10 more minutes for discussion.
- You will be assigned a time slot (10min) in which to tweet your research. We will
 be assigning these times based on your geographic location so please ensure you
 give us the correct time zone information when your register!
